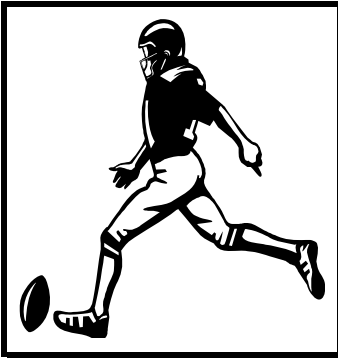
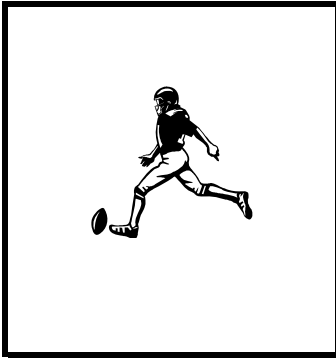


PRODUCT FRAMING AND IMAGE RESOLUTION REQUIREMENTS

Key Points

To ensure you receive the best possible Wall-a-Be, you need to fill your frame with your target object and get in as tight as you can, doing this represents Good Framing. If you use more of a scenery photo where your target object is not utilized, this represents Poor Framing. To meet our printing specifications Good Framing is a must. Three additional keys to improve the quality of your Wall-a-Be. Set your camera to the highest possible resolution (see your camera's instruction manual), always use your flash, and avoid image blur.
