

MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

Put up your Wall-A-Be in five easy steps, it's not hard, but it will take some time and patience to do it correctly. With a clean dry wall, you're just minutes away from having your Wall-a-Be on the wall.

STEP #1 - GET A FRIEND

Because some Wall-A-Be's are very large you may need an extra set of hands and some patience to get it on the wall correctly.

STEP #2 - PICK YOUR SPOT

Pick a spot where everyone can see your Wall-A-Be. Pick a smooth dry wall - most traditional walls in your house or office with standard painted dry wall work best. Clean the wall ahead of time with a warm damp sponge allowing 30 minutes to dry (DO NOT USE SOAP!). Your Wall-A-Be will not like

pebbly or textured walls. Actual size and space needed will vary depending on what size of Wall-a-you ordered.

STEP #3 - PEEL AND PLACE

BEFORE you peel your Wall-A-Be off the backing and lay it on a flat surface. Working together is the best way to carefully put your Wall-A-Be on the wall. Gently peel your Wall-a-Be off of the backing. Once you removed from the backing you are ready to place the Wall-A-Be on the wall, start at the top and work down to the bottom.

Note: If some of the backing paper comes off when you peel your Wall-A-Be, don't worry this is not a defect. Just take the time and carefully remove the excess backing.

STEP #4 - SMOOTH IT OUT

Once your Wall-A-Be has been stuck on the wall where you want it, use the squeegee to smooth out any air bubbles.

STEP #5 - SHOW IT OFF

Step back and enjoy your Wall-A-Be.

Note: Be sure to keep the items that came with your Wall-A-Be including the tube, squeegee, and the backing. You may need these items if you want to move your Wall-A-Be in the future.
